



KentuckianaWorks: SummerWorks2009

KentuckianaWorks has received \$1.4 million of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) federal funding for the KentuckianaWorks: SummerWorks2009 summer jobs program for young adults. Approximately 500 young adults will be working in the public or private sector this summer, between June 1 and September 30 in the KentuckianaWorks seven-county service area.

To be eligible for summer employment opportunities, young adults must meet low-income eligibility requirements defined by the Workforce Investment Act.

The six agencies approved by the KentuckianaWorks Board to coordinate innovative summer employment and work readiness activities for young adults, ages 16- 24, include:

- Americana Community Center (20 young adults)
- Bates Community Development Corporation (39 young adults)
- Bullitt County Adult & Community Education (114 young adults)
- Jefferson County Public Schools Adult & Continuing Education, the Y.O.U. Center (250 young adults)
- United Crescent Hill Ministries (35 young adults)
- Young Adult Development in Action Inc. (YouthBuild Louisville) (42 young adults)
